High Expectations: We demand excellence and our expectations are exceptionally high. We insist on good behaviour, full school uniform and a willingness to learn in every lesson.


An Intelligent Curriculum: While offering a broad and varied curriculum, we focus on key skills to develop strong proficiency in English and Maths.

How do we help pupils Achieve Outstanding Outcomes?

Every child is different, so we design plans and strategies that suit individuals. In addition to the timetabled lessons with our experienced team of teachers, pupils can benefit from:

- A range of interventions in subjects where pupils would benefit from extra support.
- Additional stretch and challenge are provided through refined setting along with extra-curricular opportunities that offer breadth and depth beyond the standard curriculum.

We take an enormous amount of pride in developing our pupils outside of the classroom through sport, clubs and a broad range of cultural activities. Our clubs in school cater for a wide range of interests including performing arts, debating, football, netball, technology, art and design etc.

Support, Wellbeing and Pastoral Care

For any child to learn to succeed, we know that support and opportunities to develop as an individual are crucial.

At Chapel Hill, we offer a range of support structures to ensure that school is a happy, positive, safe and inspiring experience for all pupils.



- We believe that to achieve maximum success, the school, parents and pupils must work together. We therefore partner closely with our parents from the moment our pupils enter the Nursery and School.
- Class Teachers are the main pastoral carer and the main point of communication between home and school, but are supported in this endeavour by Learning Support Assistants, Chapel Hill's Special Educational Needs Team and members of the school's Senior Leadership Team.
- Our Inclusion Team ensures that pupils who need additional help are able to access the curriculum through a range of interventions.
- We also provide emotional support to pupils who are vulnerable through counselling, mentoring and liaison with external agencies.

Wrap Around Childcare

Chapel Hill Nursery delivers truly exceptional care and learning for children from 3 months up to four years; including (subject to eligibility), 15 funded hours for 2-year-olds and 30 funded hours for 3–4-year-olds.

The school provides normal full provision for children in Nursery all year round (51 weeks) and for children in Rising 3s & 4s or attending school, we will offer normal term-time school provision complemented by breakfast club and tea time club so effectively 7.30am till 6:30pm wrap around care. This is to support working parents.

Nursery Provision

The school provides term-time Nursery provision for Rising 3s and Rising 4s.

We run three sessions:

- Morning sessions Rising 4s: 8.30am to 11.30am
- Afternoon sessions Rising 3s: 11.50am to 2.50pm
- Full-Day/30 Hour Funded Sessions





Day Care Provision

The school also provides Day Care for 0–2 year old's from 7.00am till 6:30pm as part of its wraparound care for 51 weeks, being closed between Christmas and New Year.

Breakfast & Tea-Time Club

We offer Breakfast Club and Tea-Time Club for children in Rising 3s and Rising 4s (Nursery) and in the school. Breakfast Club runs between 7.30am and 8.40am and Tea Time Club between 3.00pm and 6.30pm

Learning to Succeed
